Financial Result 2018

The Club is in a strong financial position with net cash assets of \$115,211 as at 30 September 2018 including \$80,000 lodged on Term Deposits with Westpac Banking Corporation.

The Club traded at a profit of \$20,415 during the Club's financial year compared to a loss of \$1,306 in the previous year.

As at 30 September 2018 the Club had 320 members compared to 337 members in the previous year.

Sessions conducted by the Club during the financial year were attended by 10,282 players compared to 10,847 players in the previous year. Nearly half of the decrease in numbers can be attributed to the Tuesday night session which seems to have little appeal to members of the Club. The Committee is considering various options to increase the popularity of this session.
