COVID 19 SAFETY PLAN

Applicable to the premises at Henley Community Centre

29 March 2021

Easing of Covid 19 regulations

In response to the easing of NSW Government Covid 19 regulations, this Safety Plan supersedes previous plans, removing some practices that were required when Community Transmission was widespread. However, we are mindful that a large proportion of our players are in the 70+ age-group, and accordingly our requirements may be more stringent than is mandated by the Government.

Maximum Capacity: 160 people, based on one person per two square metres of space.

Health and Wellbeing

You are not permitted to enter the premises if any of the following applies to you: -

1. You have flu-like symptoms;
2. You have had close contact with a Covid 19 positive person within the last 14 days;
3. You have had a Covid 19 test and are awaiting a negative result;
4. You are mandated to self-isolate, or mandated to restrict your movement to within a "hot-spot" area;
5. You are required to be in quarantine;
6. You have a confirmed case of Covid 19.

Precautionary Measures

- Table fees to be paid by "tap & go" system.
- Bring and use your own pen.
- Use hand sanitiser regularly; preferably when starting a new round.
- Maintain 1.5 metre separation when congregating or queuing whenever possible.
- Kitchen: tea, coffee, sugar and wooden stirers are available. Please bring own mug/cup, and try to limit the number of people in kitchen to no more than 5. At present, we cannot provide food or milk for self-service.

Reasons for relaxation of previous restrictions

The committee does not wish to be complacent about the risks of Covid 19, or the possibility of further contagious outbreaks. However, in light of recent official relaxation of restrictions, we have deleted from this Safety Plan some of the previous requirements as follows:-

- Temperature check on entry,
- QR code check-In,
- Larger table-tops,
- Wiping of boards with sanitiser wipes,
- Prohibition of person checking scores on Bridgemates from touching it.

Should community transmission of the Covid 19 virus increase, the Club will amend this Safety Plan to provide as far as is practicable a safe environment for our members and visitors.
